The Polwarth Breed Description

The Polwarth breed was founded by crossing Merino and Lincoln which was then line bred to a fixed type of ¾ Merino and ¼ Lincoln. As a result, the Polwarth is a dual purpose plain bodied sheep with minimal wrinkle. They are docile in nature, making them an easy-care animal. The Polwarth grows an open, even, soft, white, high yielding fleece of 20-24 micron. The incidence of flystrike and need for mulesing is reduced due to their plain body and open fleece. When mated to Polwarth rams or terminal sires, ewes produce quality prime lambs with an excellent ratio of lean muscle to fat.

Polwarths can be found in all states of Australia. It is important to remember that flocks experience considerable variation in climate from north to south and east to west. Breeders therefore adapt their flocks to their environmental conditions.

The following guide to selecting ewes and rams should be based on **<u>conformation</u>** and **<u>wool</u>**.

CONFORMATION

Desirable Head Traits

Head	The skull is broad with good width between the ears. The head is held high.
Poll	Well covered with an even length of staple extending to the topknot. A true Poll sheep will have hollows in the head however removable buttons/scurs are acceptable.
Face	Soft white skin and clean of wool.
Eyes	Clear, bright, kind and alert. Eyelashes are white.
Ears	Thick, soft and white.
Nose	Broad, soft and free rolling, particularly on rams.
Mouth	Broad in structure. Teeth should hit the gum pad evenly.

Desirable Body Traits

Neck	Well set on shoulders with some stretch.
Back	Straight, broad and long, carrying right through to the tail.
Hindquarters	Thick, well-muscled and look full from the rear.
Brisket	Broad and deep.
Ribs	Wide and deep. Otherwise known as the 'engine room.'

Flank	Deep and well covered.
Girth	Straight underline with good covering of wool.
Below tail	Width to handle the genitals or udder.
Breech	Barer breech is acceptable. In line with the industry's move away from mulesing, breeders may select for a barer breech.
Ram testes	Firm, even and smooth; over 30cm by 2 years of age.
Ewe udder	Even, well formed, medium sized teats and clear of wool.
Legs	Heavy boned, set squarely. Generous covering of wool preferred, however bare below the knee and hock is acceptable.
Feet	White, evenly shaped with moderate angulation of hocks and pasterns.

WOOL

Desirable Wool Traits

- Wool is soft, bright and white despite climatic variation including cold, rain, heat, dust, humidity and sunlight.
- Character is well-defined crimp.
- Ideal micron range is 20-24. A lower micron of 19 and higher micron of 25 need not disqualify as long as animals maintain their Polwarth attributes.
- Fleece is dense. As a guide, an unskirted 12-month ewe fleece should weigh 5-8kg.
- Staple length is 100-125mm for a 12-month fleece.
- Ideal yield is 74-75%.
- In terms of micron the fleece should be as even as possible with some variation acceptable. The breech area below the tail to the leg bone will be the broadest.

UNDESIRABLE TRAITS

Undesirable head traits

- Overshot or undershot jaw.
- Narrow nose, particularly on rams.
- Non-removable scurs, especially in stud rams. Acceptable in flock rams.
- Presence of harsh kempy fibres on the face or topknot. This may indicate harshness in the wool on the breech and elsewhere.
- Wool growing in front of the eyes, otherwise known as wool blindness.
- Face, eyes, eyelashes, ears and nose should be free of black/brown pigmentation in the form of spots, colour or smuttiness. Blemishes on the face is an indication of further pigmentation on the rest of the skin and body.

Undesirable body traits

- Excessive body wrinkle, especially around the neck and breech areas.
- Black stripes on feet. Distortion in the shape of hooves.
- Narrow hindquarters.
- Significant hock angulation inwards or outwards.
- Trough or ridge between the shoulder blades.

Undesirable Wool Traits

- Coloured wool (degree of yellowness) can lead to fleece rot and flystrike problems.
- Plain **wool** which lacks definition and crimp.
- Dry wool or wool with too much lanolin.
- Presence of cross fibres. The fleece should open like the pages of a book.
- Presence of dark fibres. Fibre pigmentation on the face, ears, eyelashes can be an indication of dark fibres elsewhere in the wool.
- Presence of hairy fibres on the back of the neck and breech area. Also known as medullated fibres, a good time to check is 3–4 months after shearing as these fibres grow more quickly than the wool in the first few months. Also, when shearing keep the shank or sock wool separate to fleece wool. Alternatively, leave the socks on especially the front socks as they fall into the fleece wool.

HISTORY

The polled flock of Polwarths was started at Tarndwarncoort in September 1936 by the selection from the Tarndwarncoort flock of 70 good ewes with heads of more or less poll type.

Of these, 45 were mated the following summer to a poll ram purchased from Eeyeuk (2). Ten were sent for service to a poll ram at Korongee (3) and 15 for service to a poll ram at Lariggan (16).

To these ewes were added annually for the next three years a few young ewes selected in the same way from the old Tarndwarncoort Flock No. 1. In December 1937 were added 36 ewes selected from 46 cast-for-age stud ewes purchased from Eeyeuk and in February 1939, 18 cast stud ewes were purchased from Korongee.

The above ewes and their selected increase and 7 young ewes purchased from Korongee brought the strength of the Tarndwarncoort Poll stud ewes mated in December 1943 to 174, with another 94 young ewes rising one and two years available for future selection.

Of the rams used with these ewes, the most important was an aged stud ram from Jellalabad (14) in 1937 from which stud also an additional ram was purchased for 1939 mating. Another Jellalabad ram was purchased in 1941 jointly with Lariggan stud. A poll two-year-old ram was purchased from Gala (39) and used for one season only. Further drafts of ewes, 9 in 1938 and 20 in 1940 were sent to a Lariggan ram for service.

An aged Korongee ram was used in the secondary poll flock in 1943 and 1944 but perished with a number of ewes in the January 1944 fire. A poll stud ram was purchased from Lariggan in 1943 and mated with a line of top stud ewes but died after the season was over.

In 1946 a Kooraweera (70) ram was added. In 1948 two Ormley (27) rams were added and an additional Ormley ram was hired and mated with 30 Tarndwarncoort ewes. In 1949, 47 Korongee, 132 Grattan Park, 193 Lariggan ewes and 1 Kooraweera ram and in 1950, 155 Larrigan ewes were added. From 1936 to 1945, AW Dennis carried on the flock and from 1945 to 1951 by AW Dennis and Sons, trading as Dennis Bros and since July 1951 by Norman Dennis, who acquired the sheep from the several partners after the termination of Dennis Bros.


Merino Infusion Guidelines

Consensus Statement

Underpinning the following guidelines is a need for the Polwarth breed to increase genetic diversity and desirable productivity traits.

Guidelines

- A Poll Merino or Bond ram, semen, ewes or embryos selected for infusion should mirror the Polwarth breed description in terms of conformation and wool.
- Breeders should only select a Poll Merino or Bond ram or semen with a pp (poll poll) genomic horn test.
- The Flock Book will open for two years from 1st September 2022 to 31st August 2024, allowing breeders to purchase rams, semen, ewes or embryos. Once a purchase is made, a member may use rams or ewes for their breeding lifetime.
- Breeders may only purchase and use one ram or twenty-five ewes per year.
- A Poll Merino or Bond ram, semen, ewes or embryos purchased during the two-year window are to be registered with the association as Appendix animals with full pedigree information.



A ram or semen purchased by a breeder can only be used by that breeder.

F2 rams and ewes eligible for entry into the stud and shows.

F1 and F2 Animals

- F1 animals are to be identified with a half circle ear notch on the tip of the ear the tag is placed in.
- F1 rams and ewes can be used in commercial flocks.
- As many association members have less than 100 stud ewes, it may not be viable to invest in a quality Poll Merino or Bond ram. Therefore, such studs may purchase an F1 ram from a seed stock stud to incorporate into their breeding program.
- F1 rams and ewes are not eligible to be exhibited.
- F1 rams and ewes can be joined to purebred Polwarth rams/ewes to produce F2 progeny.
- F2 progeny are considered stud animals and can be exhibited.

Alternate Method of Infusion

Another way to enter blood without taking on the sire dominant approach is purchasing Poll Merino or Bond ewes to join with a Polwarth ram. While this is a slower approach there will be less impact if things go wrong. Ideally, the progeny should throw more towards the Polwarth ram.
